VIDYARTHI VIGYAN MANTHAN



Vidyarthi Vigyan Manthan (VVM) is an initiative of Vijnana Bharati (VIBHA), in collaboration with Vigyan Prasar, an autonomous organization under the Department of Science and Technology, Government of India

and National Council of Educational Research and Training (NCERT), an institution under the Ministry of Education, earlier known as Ministry of Human Resources and Development. Vidyarthi Vigyan Manthan is a national programme for popularizing science among school students of Classes 6 to 11, conceptualised to identify the bright minds with a scientific aptitude among the student community.

Around 55 students from Classes 6 - 9 and 11 of our school participated in **Vidyarthi Vigyan Manthan** this year. The examination was held on 29th and 30th November, 2020 through the **Vidyarthi Vigyan Manthan app**.

From the junior group representing Howrah district, **Rounak Mallick of Class 7 C** secured the 1st position whereas **Apratim Roy of Class 7 A** and **Utkarsh Raj of Class 8 A** secured the 3rd position. The winners of the senior group are **Rohan Jain of Class 11 A** who secured the 1st position, **Debjoyti Ray of Class 11 A** who secured the 2nd position, **Hardik Mahawar of Class 9 D** and **Aaditya Kumar Agarwal of Class 11 A** who secured the 3rd position.

From the junior group representing Hooghly district, **Rajdeep Banerjee of Class 6 C** secured the 2nd position. The winners of the senior group are **Sreejit Dey of Class 9 A** and **Debdeep Banerjee of Class 11 A** who secured the 1st position.

Rajdeep Banerjee of Class 6 C, **Sreejit Dey of Class 9A**, **Debdeep Banerjee of Class 11 A** and **Rohan Jain of Class 11 A** have also been selected for the state camp.

All registered students for **Vidyarthi Vigyan Manthan** will become a part of "Mega nation-wide experiment for **Vidyarthi Vigyan Manthan 2020-21** students" which will start in January 2021. The Mega Nation-Wide Experiment, a novel endeavour of **Vidyarthi Vigyan Manthan**, is an experiment based on the food habits of students, nutritional value of this food and its environmental impact. This mega experiment intends to inculcate observational skills, a scientific mindset and analytical thinking

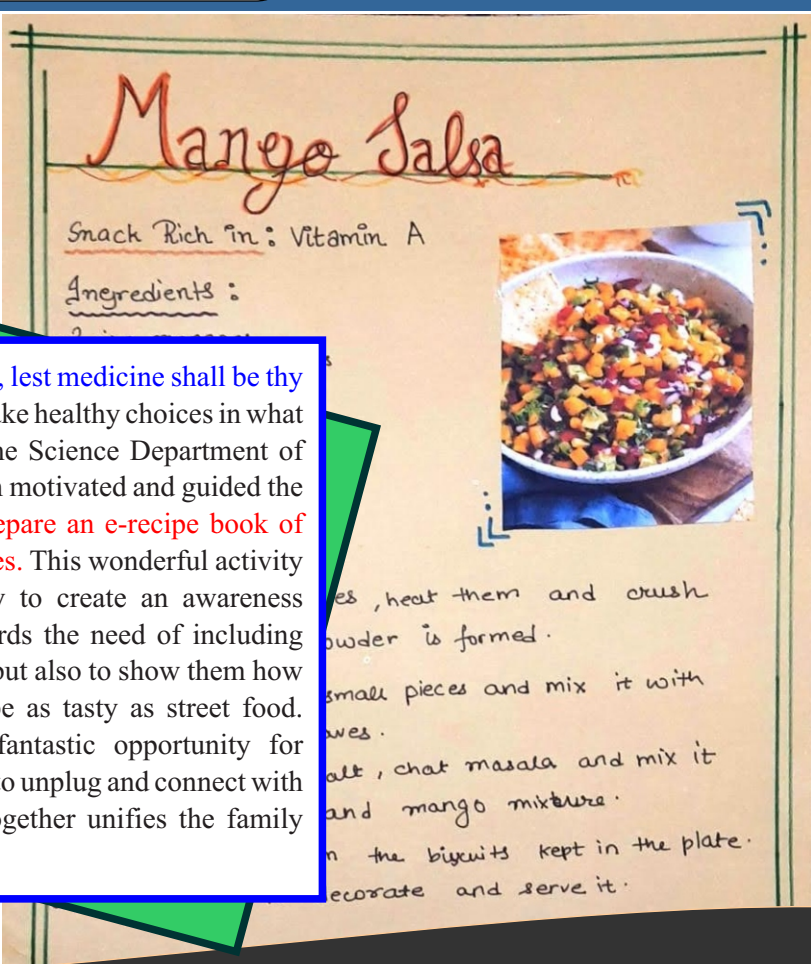
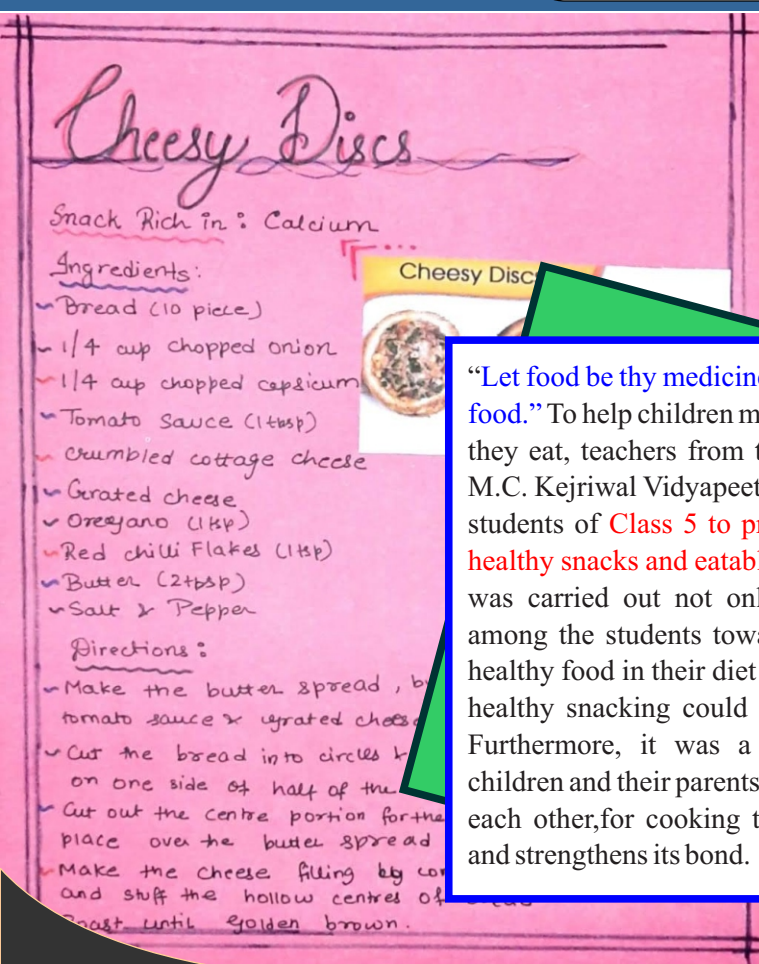


CARING FOR STRAY ANIMALS

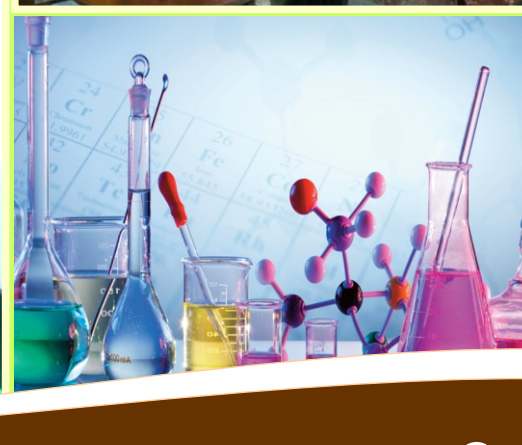
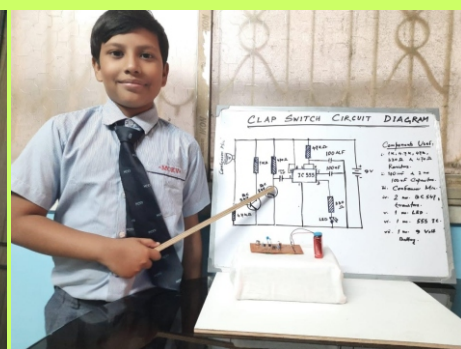
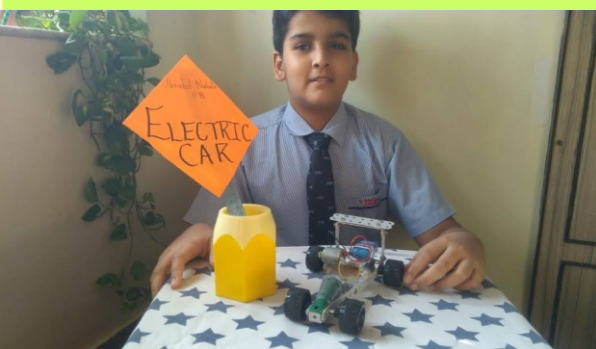
SCIENCE EXHIBITION: SYNAPSE 2020-21

PRATIDHWANI 2021, THE ANNUAL HOPE CONCERT

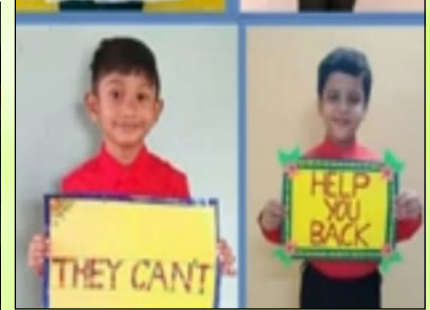
“ Hope lies in dreams, in imagination, and in the courage of those who dare to make dreams into reality”

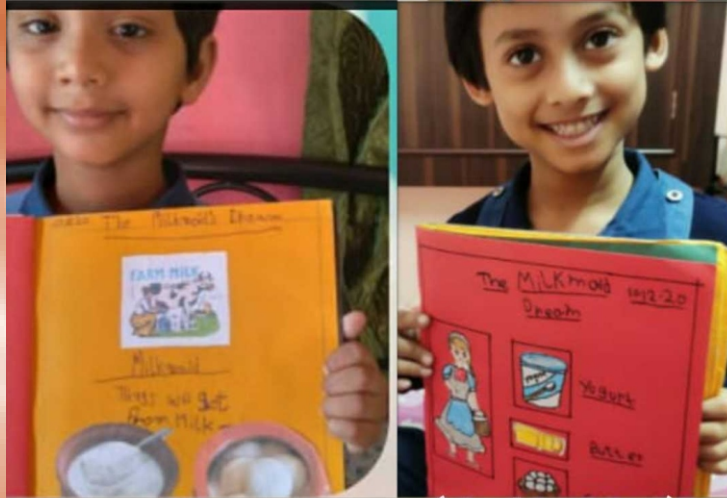

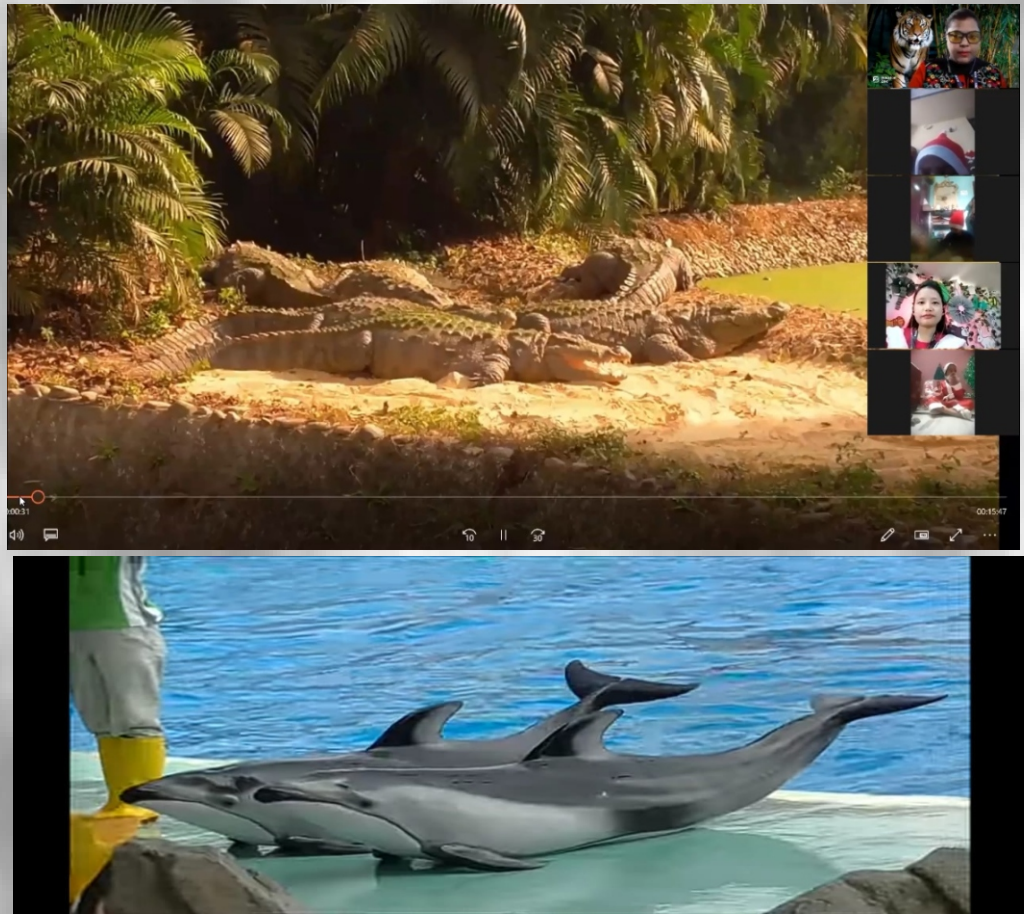
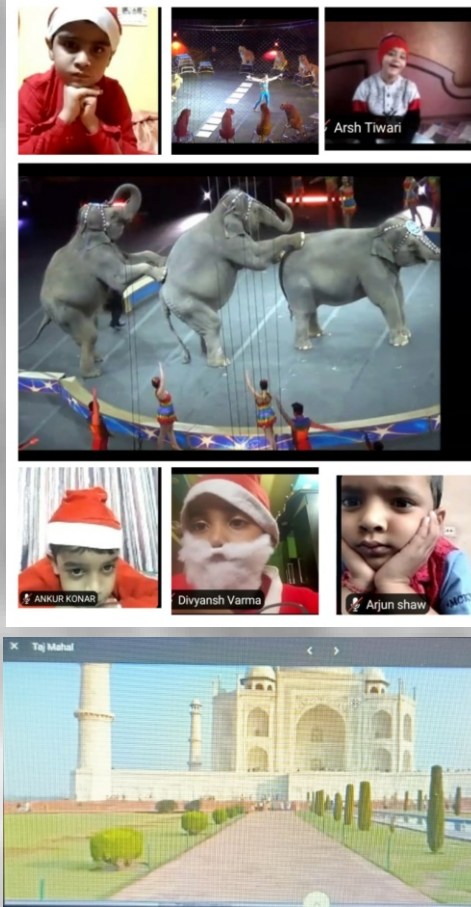
