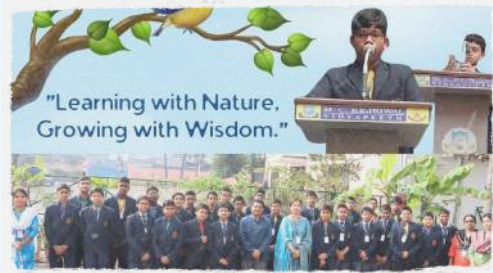

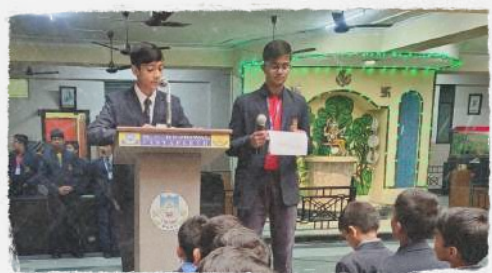
**Christmas Assembly – Festive Cheer**

### Spreading Happiness: Bal Bikash Kendra

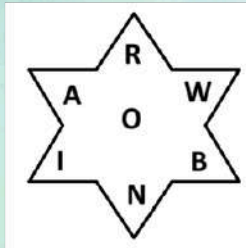
